Enrolled, An Act,

Relating to handguns; to provide that a license issued by another state which authorizes the carrying of a handgun will be recognized in this state so long as the state issuing the license recognizes handgun licenses issued to Alabama residents while Alabama residents are in that state; and to provide for the Attorney General to periodically publish a list of states which meet the reciprocity requirements of this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) A person licensed to carry a handgun in any state whose laws recognize and give effect in that state to a license issued under the laws of the State of Alabama shall be authorized to carry a handgun in this state. This act shall apply to a licenseholder from another state only while the licenseholder is not a resident of this state. A licenseholder from another state shall carry the handgun in compliance with the laws of this state.

(b) The Attorney General shall periodically publish a list of states which meet the requirements of subsection (a).
