ENROLLED, An Act,

To propose an amendment to Amendment 756 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 9, Local Amendments, Shelby County, Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, to expand the areas where the enforcement of traffic laws may be provided to include certain platted subdivisions in Shelby County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Amendment 756 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 9, Local Amendments, Shelby County, Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

"Amendment 756.

"In Shelby County, the Legislature, by local law, may provide for the enforcement of traffic laws on private roads in private gated communities and platted subdivisions with 35 or more existing houses whose roads are not public in the county."

1           Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
2 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the  
3 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section  
4 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
5 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this  
6 state.

7           Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
8 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
9 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
10 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
11 the proposed constitutional amendment:


12           "Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment

15 include certain platted subdivisions in Shelby County.


